

Helping or harming birds

Would you like to know an interesting way to encourage birds to come to your home? By providing them with nesting material, you will be offering them easy access to all the materials they need to build their nest. Birds will find twigs, fibers, plants, hairs or small branches in their surroundings to build their nests. Your contribution can also be of use to them, since you can offer them other options. From the beginning of spring until the end of the summer, birds are nesting and they will certainly appreciate your contribution to their well-being. This is a great activity to do with children.

WHAT TO OFFER:

Feathers, dry grass
Pine needles, dead leaves, lichen
Shreds of paper
Small branches, mud
Cat or dog hair **

** Make sure your pets have not been treated with a shampoo or flea product, and that the grass you offer has not been treated with pesticides or other products that could harm birds

WHAT NOT TO OFFER:

Threads, yarn, human hair
(These materials can wrap around the nestlings' feet and cut off their blood circulation)

Dryer lint

(Lint will absorb rainwater and can be infused with potentially harmful detergents or softeners)

Nature Expert offers a bag of nesting materials including 7 sterilized materials.



Materials can be placed in the hollow of a tree, on top of a shrub, on the ground, or even in a suet cage.

The birds will choose very carefully the materials needed and will look for several elements to build their nest. Thank you for collaborating and ... we wish you some great observations.

Grand Défi QuébecOiseaux

Some of you might know Sophie Thibault, newscaster for TVA for many years now. What you may not know is that she is very passionate about photography and birds!


We are now selling some of her products, featuring her breathtaking photographs. Part of the profits will go to nature conservation organizations.
