Why don't birds fall off tree branches when they sleep?

When birds perch, there is a flexor tendon in their legs that gets pulled and locks their toes tightly to the branch. Birds' "knees" bend backwards, so when they perch the flexor tendons are pulled to their furthest extent over the back of the knee.
